

Conditions of Entry

Sunday Ticket 2026

In consideration of attending this event, you agree to follow the reasonable guidelines set forth by Experience Gold Coast (the **Organiser**) for the duration of the event:

- You must have a valid ticket or other authorisation/accreditation to enter the event;
- Each ticket is only valid for the admission of one person;
- Patrons must be 18 years of age or over and will be required to present valid photo ID as proof of age upon entry to event security;
 - Valid forms of identification include:
 - 18+ Passports,
 - Photo Driver Licence
 - Proof of Age card
 - International Passports
 - Digital IDs
 - International Photo Drivers Licence
 - Invalid forms of identification include anything that isn't listed above such as:
 - Photo identification that has been tampered with
 - Photo identification that is expired
 - Photos of identification documents
- Any person gaining unauthorised access to this event may be liable to prosecution;
- Organisers reserve the right to conduct reasonable searches of all persons, bags and belongings at the time of entry to the event. Failure to comply will mean you will be prevented from entering the event;
- The Organiser reserves the right to deny admission to the holder of any ticket that appears to have been tampered with, counterfeited, or duplicated. Forging a ticket to an event will result in immediate removal from the event. The Organiser reserves the right to refer any matter involving the alleged falsification of tickets to events to the police;
- Your ticket will be exchanged for a wristband that you must keep on for the duration of the event. Lost, damaged or stolen wristbands will not be replaced. Anyone found at an event without a wristband may be removed from the event at the Organiser's discretion;
- This event is conducted under a liquor license. No BYO alcohol is permitted. All alcohol sales are subject to Responsible Service of Alcohol (**RSA**) requirements and harm minimisation practices. By law, alcohol cannot be served to anyone who is under 18 years of age, or to any person who is intoxicated. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse service, remove alcohol, or eject any person who breaches these requirements;
- Activities such as 'stage diving', 'moshing', 'climbing', 'crowd surfing' and sitting on other attendee's shoulders are strictly prohibited. Any person engaging in these or other unsafe behaviours may be refused entry, removed from the event, and/or banned from future events at the Organiser's reasonable discretion;
- Any person causing a disturbance, behaving in a disruptive or unsafe manner or refusing to comply with the reasonable directions of security and event staff may be refused entry and/or removed from the event in the Organiser's absolute discretion;
- The Organiser reserves the right to refuse entry or reject patrons from the event at its sole discretion, where, in the Organiser's reasonable opinion, it is necessary to

do so for safety, security, legal compliance or to ensure the enjoyment of other patrons;

- By entering the event site, you acknowledge that attendance to events of this nature carry inherent risks, and you voluntarily accept and assume all such risks. To the maximum extent permitted by law, you release, indemnify, and hold harmless the Organiser, its staff, contractors, and agents from any liability or loss, injury, damage, claims or expenses of any kind that you may suffer or incur in connection with your attendance at the event, this includes any claims arising from your own actions, omissions, or negligence, except to the extent caused by the Organiser's reckless disregard or wilful misconduct. Nothing in these terms excludes any rights or remedies you may have under the Australian Consumer Law which cannot be lawfully excluded;
- By entering this event site, you agree to be filmed or photographed and you grant the Organiser permission to use your image, likeness, and voice in any media, worldwide and in perpetuity, for marketing, promotional and related purposes, without compensation;
- The Organiser reserves the right to vary advertised programmes and to add, withdraw or substitute artists where necessary;
- Volume levels at all outdoor events vary depending on many factors such as EPA noise restrictions and may or may not be as loud as an indoor event. Those choosing to enter the event do so at their own discretion;
- Smoking (cigarettes and e-cigarettes) is only permitted in designated smoking areas;
- Any person bearing offensive patches or insignias that are deemed offensive or threatening, will be refused entry to the event at the Organiser's discretion. The Organiser reserves the right to exercise this discretion to ensure the safety and enjoyment of all patrons;
- Anyone who breaches the conditions of entry to the event or engages in any unsafe, anti-social or disruptive behaviour, or otherwise acts in a manner deemed inappropriate by the Organiser will be refused entry and/or removed from the site without refund. The Organiser reserves the right to exercise this discretion at all times to ensure the safety, security and enjoyment of all patrons;
- By using the medical facilities available at the event, you consent to the Organiser and/or attending personnel collecting and using your medical and personal information and records for the purposes of providing appropriate medical treatment.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

The following restricted or prohibited items are not permitted by patrons into the event:

- Glass bottles or cans including perfume and makeup;
- Alcoholic beverages, e-cigarette liquids, and foreign liquids;
- Open drinks (only sealed non-alcoholic drinks and empty reusable water bottles are allowed into the event);
- Illicit drugs;
- Steel cap boots;

- No steel-framed folding chairs, deck chairs, or reclining chairs will be permitted into the event. Basic canvas camping chairs with a back no higher than 110cm will be permitted. At a certain time, those wanting to still use a chair will be directed to relocate to a designated seating area;
- Knives or other dangerous weapons including potential missiles;
- Flares, fireworks, or sparklers;
- Lasers or laser pointers;
- Animals or pets other than guide dogs and companion pets (paperwork must be provided);
- Professional recording or broadcast devices without the Organisers permission;
- Drones or other airborne recording/photography devices;
- Flags with poles, large flags, or banners (over 60cm long) that may obstruct the view of other patrons;
- Any item that you intend (or such quantities of the item from which Management can reasonably infer that you intend) to distribute, hawk, sell, offer, expose for sale, or display for marketing or promotional purposes;
- Large items including hard eskies, hard drink coolers, or ice boxes;
- Umbrellas;
- Any other items as determined by security or management that may be deemed as dangerous goods, cause injury or public nuisance;
- Any prohibited items found will be confiscated. Alcohol will be disposed of, illegal substances or weapons or items considered dangerous, or offensive will be handed over to the police.

PRESCRIPTION MEDICINE

Medication is allowed to be brought into the event, under the following conditions:

- It must be in its original packaging and untampered. This must be placed in a clear, resealable bag accompanied by the proof of script and requirement;
- All medication will undergo normal security processes upon entry. At the discretion of the Front Gate / Security Manager;
- You may be required to present medication to the Event Medical Team before entering the event;
- Medication may be required to be held at the Event Medical Operations Unit until the attendee who possesses the medication exits the event.
