ACCOMMODATION PERFORMANCE SUMMARY - MAY 2025

The month of May held several major events, including the Bonsoy Gold Coast Pro, Out 2 Lunch Festival, Gold Coast Careers Festival, Blues on Broadbeach, International Boat Show and SeaFire.

Public holidays were observed in QLD and NT for Labour Day on May 5.

Average occupancy across the month of May was 61.6%; equalling last year. The average daily rate (ADR) was \$252; which was up +4.7% versus last year (\$241).

Forward bookings occupancy for the next 28 days (at June 23) averaged 64%, a slight increase versus the same time last year (61%).

FORWARD OCCUPANCY FOR NEXT 90 DAYS



Occupancy = Percent sold of available rooms.

ADR (Average Daily Rate) = Room revenue divided by rooms sold.

RevPAR (Revenue Per Available Room) = Room revenue divided by rooms available.

Forward Occupancy = Reservations within the system on any given date.

The downward trajectory is expected and indicates how far forward consumers are willing to book.
