Professor Mark Von Itzstein AO, Griffith University's, Director and Founder, Institute for Glycomics, co-inventor of the world's first anti-flu drug Relenza. He says that the Gold Coast is now establishing itself as a biomedical research hub.

He says his team has unprecedented access to world class onsite research facilities and exceptional partnership opportunities to support his globally recognised excellence in Interventional Neurovascular expertise.

Professor Huijun Zhao, Bsc, Msc, Phd, Director Centre for Clean Environment and Energy, Deputy Director, Environmental Futures Research Institute, Griffith University. He says the Gold Coast offers the opportunity to work on internationally recognised programs to tackle the most challenging issues of our generation — clean energy, environment and water. He leads a ground-breaking team responsible for vaccine development for both a broad spectrum malaria vaccine, PlasProtecT<sup>TM</sup> and a nasal-delivery vaccine for the deadly Group A Streptococcus bacteria.
