Careers Outreach Service & Mobile Gold Coast Student Hub

Study Gold Coast member organisations can access our Careers Outreach Service for engaging presentations directly to students. This service complements your institution's support services by providing high-quality career support on your campus or remotely via webinars. Each presentation is adapted to the student audience such as; high school, vocational or higher education students and can be delivered in small or large groups.



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PRESENTATION TOPICS & LEARNING OUTCOMES

Future Career Insights & Options Post Study (1 hour) - Insights into the world of work and how it is changing. Students learn career education terminology, discover career resources such as the careers explorer tool and future employment industries to support students in making informed career choices around their options post study.



Career Planning & Digital Footprint (1 hour) - Understanding self, interests and values and discover digital tools to support students in designing their future career. Discuss digital footprints and the impact they can have on an individual's future career. For high school students, they receive a demonstration of the Careers Explorer tool and how career bullseyes can inform senior subject selection.

Job Search Strategies & Applications (1 hour) - Effective job search strategies, how to apply for an advertised position or a vocational placement, researching an employer and workplace etiquette. Understanding the job market using the Gold Coast Student Jobs site. Writing a resume, identifying keywords and required skills plus the structure of a resume and applicant tracking systems.



Interview Preparation (1 hour) – How to effectively prepare for interviews by understanding the various interview types used by employers. How body language can impact success. What is behavioural questioning and how to use a formula to demonstrate your skills and experience.



Job Ready Skills (1 hour) - This presentation is for high school students. With practical resources to assist students to become job ready as they navigate the Australian workplace, through understanding workplace culture, employer expectations and work rights.

Navigating the Australian Workplace (1 hour) - This presentation is for international students. Where they learn practical resources to assist students to become job ready as they navigate the Australian workplace, through understanding workplace culture, employer expectations and work rights.



Networking with LinkedIn (1 hour) - Tips and tools for networking through building connections including creating a LinkedIn profile and how it is used as a recruitment tool for talent and informational interviews.

Fostering an Entrepreneurial Mindset (1 hour) - What is an entrepreneurial mindset and how can student's discover opportunities to become entrepreneurial. Where to find resources and support to assist students on their career journey. This presentation aligns with the Australian Curriculum: Work Studies unit.



Career Exploration and GC Jobs (30 mins) - This is a short presentation showcasing Study Gold Coast's career and employability initiatives for students. The topics covered can include Careers Explorer Tool, Study Course Guide, Gold Coast Student Jobs site, where to find Career & Employability Resources and Student Support via the Gold Coast Student Hub. This presentation complements SET planning or career information events via the Mobile Gold Coast Student Hub van.



Educator's Presentation - Careers & Employability with Study Gold Coast (1 hour) - A professional development opportunity for teaching and support staff with a range of careers and employability topics covered, including: Sources of current career information and resources via the Careers Outreach Service; finding employment opportunities like work experience, volunteering and part-time employment using the Gold Coast Student Jobs site; directing students to careers and welfare support through the Gold Coast Student Hub.



Mock Group Interviews (2 hours) - An opportunity for students to plan and prepare for group interviews, plus practice answering behavioural type questions in a mock speed interview setting.



Webinar Presentations: This is a one-hour webinar version of any of the above Careers Outreach presentations topics. A link to the webinar will be emailed once the booking is confirmed. This link can then be shared with students/attendees.

MOBILE GOLD COAST STUDENT HUB

The Mobile Gold Coast Student Hub is an innovative vehicle that features an interactive zone with virtual reality headsets showcasing 3D work experiences, an extendable screen for use with presentations, plus a Nintendo Switch gaming console that can bring a fun and engaging approach at your next event. Students can speak with the Study Gold Coast team to discuss career options, digital tools and to learn about the Gold Coast Student Jobs site and Gold Coast Student Hub.
