

## **ACCOMMODATION PERFORMANCE SUMMARY - AUGUST 2025**

The month of August held several major events, including the BLEACH Festival, the Volleyball Queensland Senior Schools Cup, and the Australian Open and Oceania World Taekwondo Presidents Cup. Public holidays were observed on August 4 in NT for Picnic Day, August 13 in Brisbane for the Ekka, and August 29 in Gold Coast for the Gold Coast Show.

Average occupancy across the month of August was 70.2%, -4.2 points lower versus last year (74.4%). The average daily rate (ADR) was \$251, slightly lower versus last year (\$252). Forward bookings occupancy for the next 28 days (at September 22) averaged 74%, +2 points higher versus the same time last year (72%).



**Occupancy** = Percent sold of available rooms.

**ADR** (Average Daily Rate) = Room revenue divided by rooms sold.

**Forward Occupancy** = Reservations within the system on any given date.

The downward trajectory is expected and indicates how far forward consumers are willing to book.
