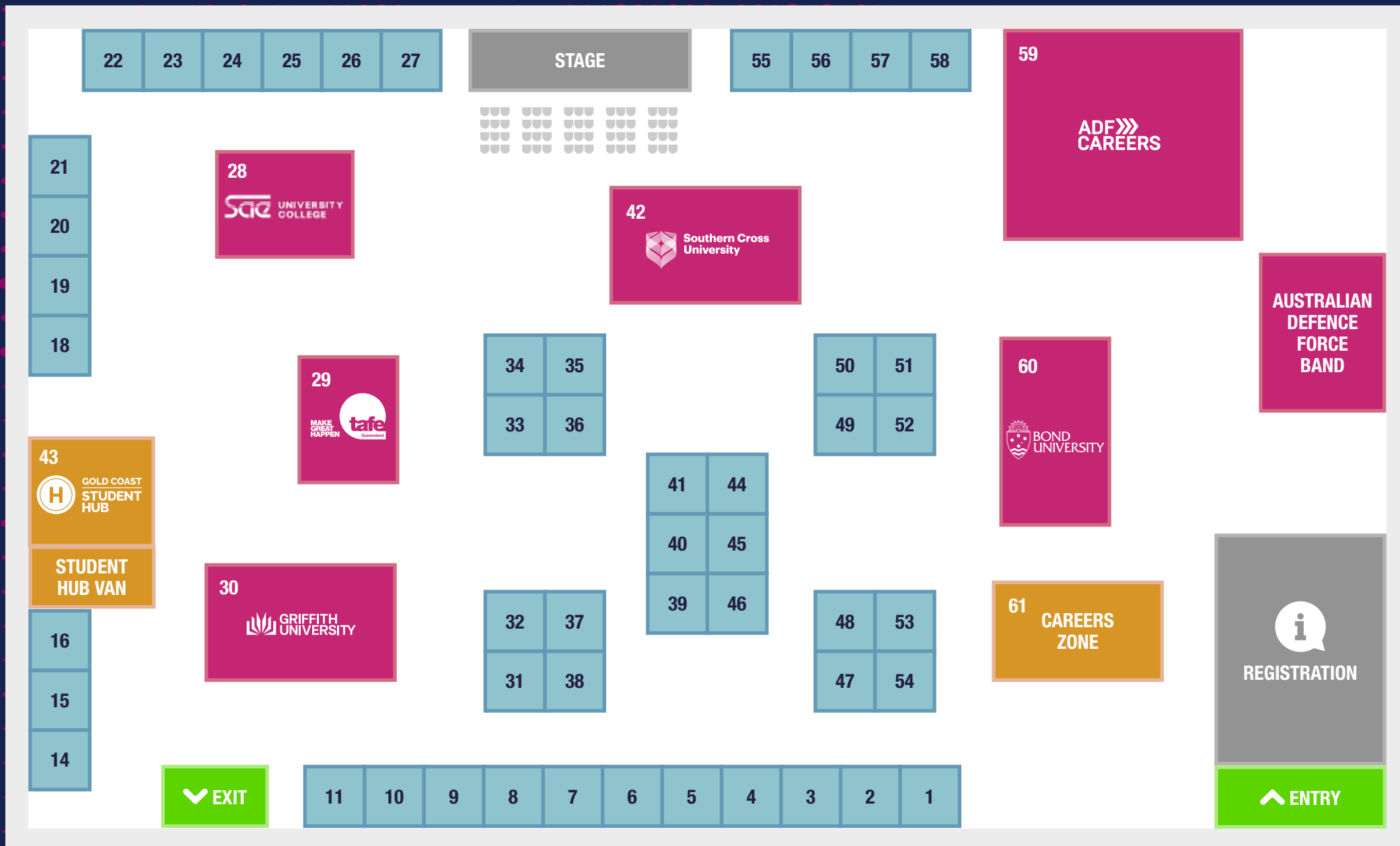

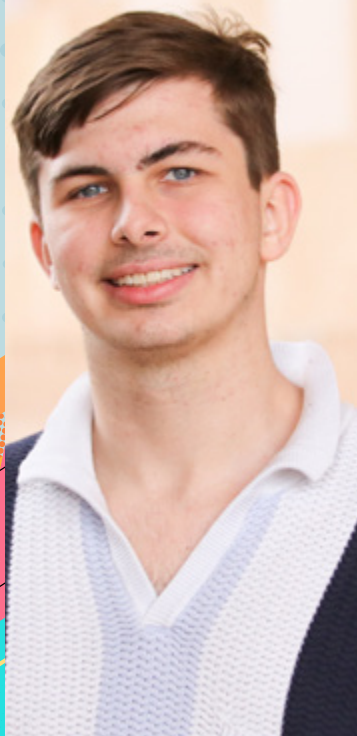

Aboard a 62-foot yacht in the Whitsundays, Chelcie Jones faced a crisis. With the engine failing and the boat drifting toward rocks, she dove in, tools in hand. When it roared back to life, so did her future.

"That was the moment I knew—I loved fixing engines more than sailing them," she said. Chelcie transitioned from building luxury motor yachts to hands-on mechanical repairs. Now in her fourth year of a Heavy Diesel Mechanics course at TAFE Queensland's Ashmore campus, she's proving skill, not gender, defines success. Chelcie has had to prove herself repeatedly—not just to others, but to herself.

"Being a woman in trade means constantly proving that I deserve to be here," she said. "There's always going to be that one person who doubts you, but I've learned to let my skills speak for themselves."

At five feet tall and 50 kilos, she's had to work smarter, not harder. "If I can't do something the way I was shown, I figure out my own way."

Her advice to other women considering a trade career?

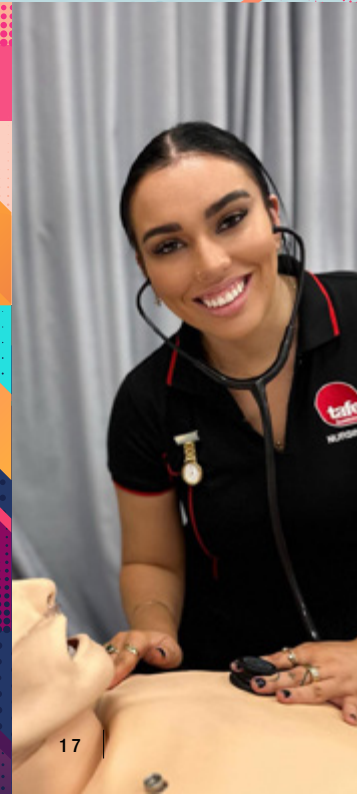
"Confidence, adaptability, and perseverance are key," Chelcie said. "Believe in your skills, find your own way, and as you grow, bring other women along with you."

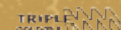
